On this trip I was to be aided by my trusty co-pilot and daughter Kylie Virg, who at the ripe old age of 13 has no idea what she is getting into. Shortly before the planned trip Ted received a call from Los Angeles that needed a rescued mother and 3 puppies flown from Indianapolis to L.A. So the plan changed, long story short, Kylie misses school for a week and we go from Louisville to Indianapolis to Los Angeles to San Antonio to Laconia, NH and then back to Louisville. 12:00 pm Here come the mountains!

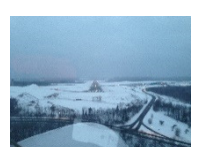
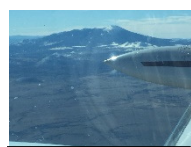
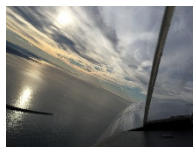
3:00 pm
