## RECENT MISSION: LOUISVILLE TO NASHVILLE TO NY IN LESS THAN 12 HOURS???

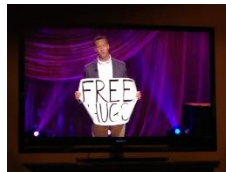

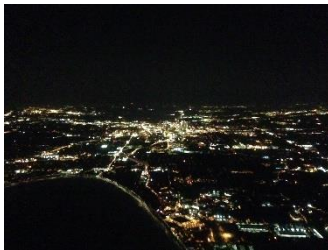
**4:00pm Tuesday**

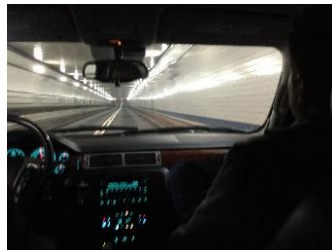
**5:00pm Tuesday**
